**The Town and Country Planning General Development
(Amendment) Order 1967**

<i>Made</i> - - - -	19th July 1967
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	25th July 1967
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	10th August 1967

The Minister of Housing and Local Government, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 14 and 217 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1962(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Town and Country Planning General Development (Amendment) Order 1967, and the Town and Country Planning General Development Orders 1963 to 1965(b) and this order may be cited together as the Town and Country Planning General Development Orders 1963 to 1967.

(2) This order shall come into operation on 10th August 1967.

(3) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1963(d) as amended(e) is hereby amended by the substitution, in column (2) of Class VI.1 in Part I of Schedule 1, for condition 2 therein, of the following condition namely:—

“2. The height of any building or works shall not exceed 10 feet in the case of a building or works within 2 miles of the perimeter of an aerodrome nor 40 feet in any other case.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This order amends the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1963 by imposing a maximum height limit of 40 feet on agricultural buildings and works which may be erected under the permission granted by article 3 and Class VI.1 in Part I of Schedule 1 to that Order. Previously the only height limit was that of 10 feet imposed on buildings and works within 2 miles of the perimeter of an aerodrome and this is continued.
