**The Town and Country Planning General Development
(Amendment) Order 1973**

Made - - - 21st February 1973

Laid before Parliament 28th February 1973

Coming into Operation 1st March 1973

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 31(3) of and Schedules 11 and 14 to the Town and Country Planning Act 1971(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the Town and Country Planning General Development (Amendment) Order 1973 and shall come into operation on 1st March 1973.

2. The Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1973(b) is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) In article 14(1) there shall be inserted after “local planning authority” the words and brackets “(other than the Common Council, the Greater London Council and the Council of a London borough)”;

(b) For the figures “1972” which appear in the heading and in Certificates B and C of the prescribed form set out in Part I of Schedule 5, and in the heading of the prescribed forms set out in Parts II and III of Schedule 5 and in Part I of Schedule 6 there shall be substituted the figures “1973”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order corrects the omission of a provision in article 14(1), which appeared in the former article 11A(1), excluding local planning authorities in Greater London from its operation.

It also corrects an error in the heading and text of certain prescribed forms relating to Established Use Certificates.
