TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (GENERAL PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT) ORDER 1995 AS AMENDED

DIRECTION MADE UNDER ARTICLE 4(1) TO WHICH ARTICLE 5 APPLIES

WHEREAS: Exeter City Council ("the Authority") being the appropriate local planning authority within the meaning of article 4 (4) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 as amended ("the 1995 Order"), is satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description set out in the First Schedule below should not be carried out within the area of land described in the Second Schedule below, unless planning permission is granted on an application made under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 as amended,

NOW THEREFORE the Authority in pursuance of the power conferred on it by article 4 (1) of the 1995 Order HEREBY DIRECTS that the permission granted by article 3 of the 1995 Order shall not apply to development of the description set out in the First Schedule below, on land within the area described in the Second Schedule below.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Development consisting of a change of the use of a building from a use falling within Class C3 (dwellinghouses) of the Schedule to the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order 1987 as amended, to a use falling within Class C4 (houses in multiple occupation) of that Schedule, being development comprised within Class I (b) of Part 3 of Schedule 2 to the 1995 Order and not being development comprised within any other Class.

The land shown coloured pink on the attached plan (being the whole of the land comprised in the St James electoral ward and parts of the Duryard, Newtown, Pennsylvania, Polsloe and St Davids electoral wards in the City of Exeter).
