

## **TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990**

### **TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (GENERAL PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT) ORDER 1995 (AS AMENDED)**

#### **Direction made under Article 4(1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 (as amended)**

Thanet District Council ("the Authority") is the appropriate local planning authority within the meaning of article 4(4) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995, as amended ("the Order") in respect of the area of land specified in this Direction.

The Authority is satisfied that it is expedient that development described in Schedule 2 to the Order and specified in this Direction should not be carried out unless permission is granted on an application made to the Authority under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Authority in pursuance of the power conferred on it by Article 4(1) of the Order and all other powers thereby enabling

**DIRECTS THAT** the permission granted by Article 3 of the Order shall not apply to development specified in the First Schedule to this Direction in the area specified in the Second Schedule to this Direction.

**THIS DIRECTION** shall come into force on **4 February 2012** but shall not come into force until confirmed by the Authority in accordance with paragraphs (9) and (10) of Article 5 of the Order.

**THIS DIRECTION** may be cited as the Thanet District Council (Administrative Area) Town and Country Planning Direction 2011

### **FIRST SCHEDULE**

#### **Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 (as amended)**

##### **Schedule 2, Part 3 Changes of Use Class I(b)**

Development consisting of a change of use of a building to a use falling within Class C4 (houses in multiple occupation) of the Schedule to the Use Classes Order 1987, as amended from a use falling within Class C3 (dwellinghouses) of that Schedule.

### **SECOND SCHEDULE**

The administrative area of Thanet District Council, shown for identification purposes edged red on the attached Plan.
