**NORTHAMPTON BOROUGH COUNCIL**

**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (GENERAL PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT) ORDER  
1995 (AS AMENDED)**

**DIRECTION MADE UNDER ARTICLE 4(1) TO WHICH ARTICLE 6 APPLIES**

WHEREAS Northampton Borough Council ("the Council") being the appropriate local planning authority within the meaning of article 4(4) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 (as amended) ("the Order") are satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description set out in the Schedule below should not be carried out on the land shown edged red on the attached plan ("the land") unless planning permission is granted on an application made under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).

NOW THEREFORE the Council in pursuance of the power conferred on them by article 4(1) of the Order hereby direct that the permission granted by article 3 of the Order shall not apply to development on the land of the description set out in the Schedule below.

THIS DIRECTION is made under article 4(1) of the Order and, in accordance with article 6(7) of the Order shall remain in force until **14 August 2011** (being six months from the date of this direction) and shall then expire unless it has been confirmed by the appropriate local planning authority in accordance with paragraphs (9) and (10) of article 5 of the Order before the end of the six month period.

**SCHEDULE**

A change of the use of a building to a use falling within Class C4 (houses in multiple occupation) of the Schedule to the Town and Country (Use Classes) Order 1987 (as amended) from a use falling within Class C3 (dwellinghouses) of the Schedule to the Town and Country (Use Classes) Order 1987 (as amended) being development comprised within Class I of Part 3 of Schedule 2 to the Order and not being development comprised within any other Class.


